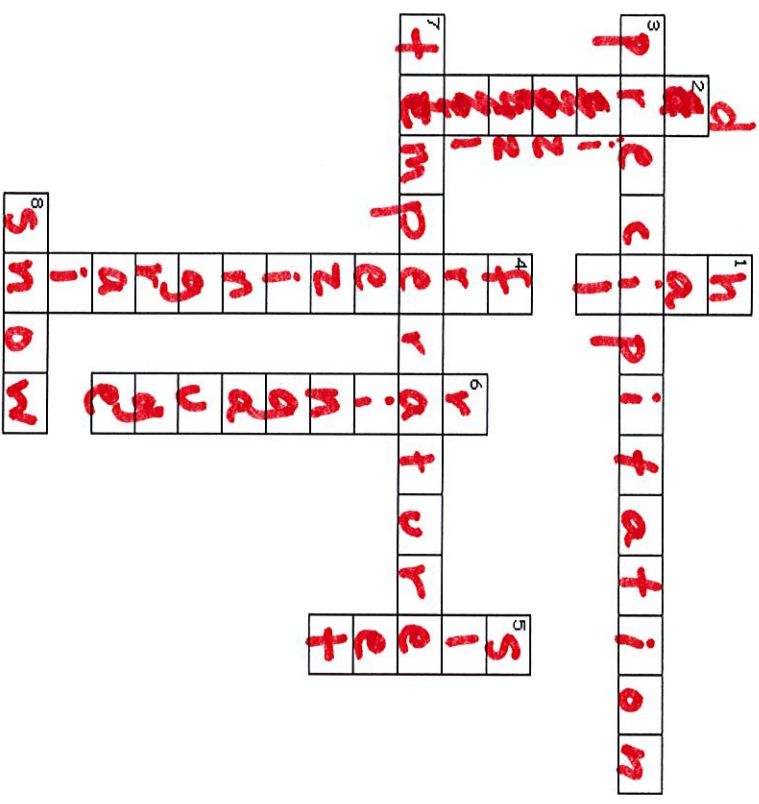


Precipitation

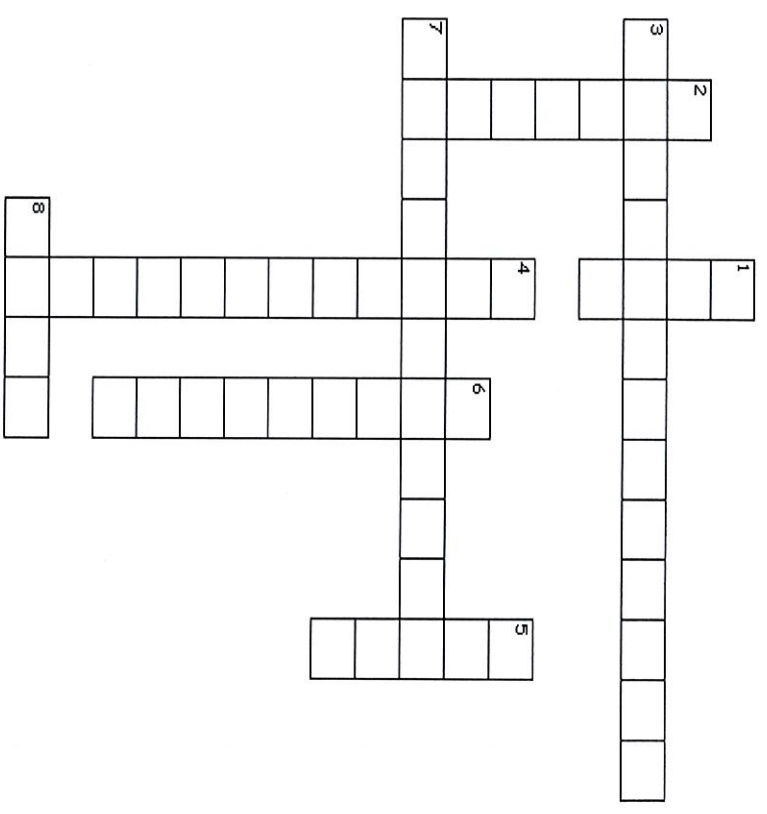


- Across
- part of the water cycle where water falls to Earth in liquid or solid form
 - factor that decides which type of precipitation you will receive
 - freezes into a crystal in the cloud and then falls to Earth in frozen form

Down

- ice that gets tossed up and down in clouds building in layers of ice; falls as a clump of ice
- small sized drops of rain
- freezes when it lands on the ground or another surface that is cold
- rain that freezes as it falls and lands as ice pellets
- tool use to measure the amount of rainfall

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
